**SUBJECT: Part B Detail Line Expansion - Trailer 08 Update**

**I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES:** CMS believes that there is a need to expand the downstream systems to allow for 50 detail lines. The modification to the Common Working File (CWF) Trailer 08 benefits all impacted parties by introducing a consistent and more efficient mechanism for communication of claim detail level error code information. The CWF Trailer 08 changes are preparatory and necessary for the expansion to fifty claim details.

Note: The changes for this CR are effective based on receipt date and not on date of service.
