**SUBJECT: Hemophilia Clotting Factor Indicator on Average Sales Price (ASP) Drug Pricing File**

**I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES:** In order for FIs and Part A MACs to make appropriate payment for the blood clotting factor in an efficient and effective manner, CMS has modified the Average Sales Price (ASP) drug pricing file format to include a field that will identify a HCPCS code as being eligible for the add-on payment. This instruction includes a new ASP drug pricing file format that is intended for FI and Part A-MAC use only.

## I. GENERAL INFORMATION

**A. Background:** Section 1842(o)(5) of the Social Security Act allows for payment of a blood clotting factor add-on fee. In order for FIs and Part A MACs to make appropriate payment for blood clotting factors in an efficient and effective manner, CMS has modified the ASP drug pricing file format to include a field that will identify a HCPCS code as being eligible for the add-on payment. This instruction includes a new ASP drug pricing file format.

**B. Policy:** Beginning July 1, 2009, a new “clotting factor” column will be included in future ASP pricing files. In this column, the indicator “1” will identify the nationally priced clotting factors with a unique HCPCS code. Instructions on the intended use of this column are provided in Change Request 6354. Only the FIs and Part A MACs will update the hemophilia indicator with new hemophilia clotting factors using the Part B drug pricing files (ASP) that are issued quarterly by CMS.
