

Medicare Eligible Hospitals, Critical Access Hospitals and Dual-Eligible Hospitals Promoting Interoperability Program Stage 3 Objectives and Measures for 2018

Eligible Hospital, Critical Access Hospital, Dual Eligible Hospital Objectives and Measures	
(1)	Protect electronic protected health information (ePHI) - created or maintained by the certified electronic health record (CEHRT) through the implementation of appropriate technical, administrative, and physical safeguards.
(2)	Generate and transmit permissible discharge prescriptions electronically .
(3)	Patient Electronic Access - Provides patients (or patient authorized representative) with timely electronic access to their health information and patient-specific education.
(4)	Coordination of Care - Use CEHRT to engage with patients or their authorized representatives about the patient's care.
(5)	Health Information Exchange - The eligible hospital or critical access hospital (CAH) provides a summary of care record when transitioning or referring their patient to another setting of care, receives or retrieves a summary of care record upon the receipt of a transition or referral or upon the first patient encounter with a new patient, and incorporates summary of care information from other providers into their EHR using the functions of CEHRT.
(6)	Public Health Reporting - The eligible hospital or CAH is in active engagement with a public health agency or clinical data registry to submit electronic public health data in a meaningful way using CEHRT, except where prohibited, and in accordance with applicable law and practice.
