Medicare-only Eligible Professionals

Doctors of Optometry Doctors of Podiatric Medicine Chiropractor Medicaid-only Eligible Professionals

> Nurse Practitioners Certified Nurse-Midwives

Physician Assistants (PAs) when working at an FQHC or RHC that is so led by a PA

Doctors of Medicine Doctors of Osteopathy Doctors of Dental Medicine or Surgery

Could be eligible for both Medicare & Medicaid



### **Medicare Eligible Professionals**

- Must be a physician (defined as MD, DO, DDM/DDS, optometrist, podiatrist, chiropractor)
- Must have Part B Medicare allowed charges
- Must not be hospital-based
- Must be enrolled in Provider Enrollment, Chain and Ownership System (PECOS) and in an 'approved status', living



# **Before you Register**

Eligible Professional should have the following:

- National Provider Identifier (NPI)
- National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) web user account
- Be currently enrolled in Provider Enrollment, Chain and Ownership System (PECOS)
  - If you are not enrolled in PECOS then you should still register for the EHR Incentive Program
- Payee NPI (if you are reassigning your benefits)

#### Eligible Professionals (EP)

- If you are an EP, you must have an active National Provider Identifier (NPI) and have a National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) web user account. Use your NPPES user ID and password to log into this system.
- If you are an EP who does not have an NPI and/or an NPPES web user account, navigate to <u>NPPES</u> to apply for an NPI and/or create an NPPES web user account.
- Users working on behalf of an Eligible Professional(s) must have an Identity and Access Management system (I&A) web user
  account (User ID/Password) and be associated to the Eligible Professional's NPI. If you are working on behalf of an Eligible
  Professional(s) and do not have an I&A web user account, <u>Create a Login</u> in the I&A System.

#### **Eligible Hospitals**

- If you are an Eligible Hospital, you must have an active NPI. If you do not have an NPI, apply for an NPI in NPPES 🖳
- Users working on behalf of an Eligible Hospital(s) must have an Identity and Access Management system (I&A) web user account (User ID/Password) and be associated to an organization NPI. If you are working on behalf of an Eligible Hospital(s) and do not have an I&A web user account, <u>Create a Login</u> in the I&A System.

#### Account Management

### Notable Differences between the Medicare and Medicaid EHR Incentive Programs

Medicare	Medicaid
Federal Government will implement (will be an option nationally)	Voluntary for States to implement (may not be an option in every State)
Payment reductions begin in 2015 for providers that do not demonstrate Meaningful Use	No Medicaid payment reductions
Must demonstrate MU in Year 1	A/I/U option for 1st participation year
Maximum incentive is \$44,000 for EPs (10% bonus for EPs in HPSAs)	Maximum incentive is \$63,750 for EPs
Meaningful Use definition is common for Medicare	States can adopt certain additional requirements for Meaningful Use
Last year a provider may initiate program is 2014; Last year to register is 2016; Payment adjustments begin in 2015	Last year a provider may initiate program is 2016; Last year to register is 2016
Only physicians, subsection (d) hospitals and CAHs	5 types of EPs, acute care hospitals (including CAHs) and children's hospitals
