



Factors Accounting for Average Annual Growth in Selected Types of Personal Health Care Expenditures: Selected Periods 1970-2018






Figure 1.3 Personal Health Care Expenditures, by Source of Funds: Selected Calendar Years 1960-2007







Figure 1.4 Percent Change in Medicare, Medicaid, and Personal Health Care Expenditures: Calendar Years 1970-2007
