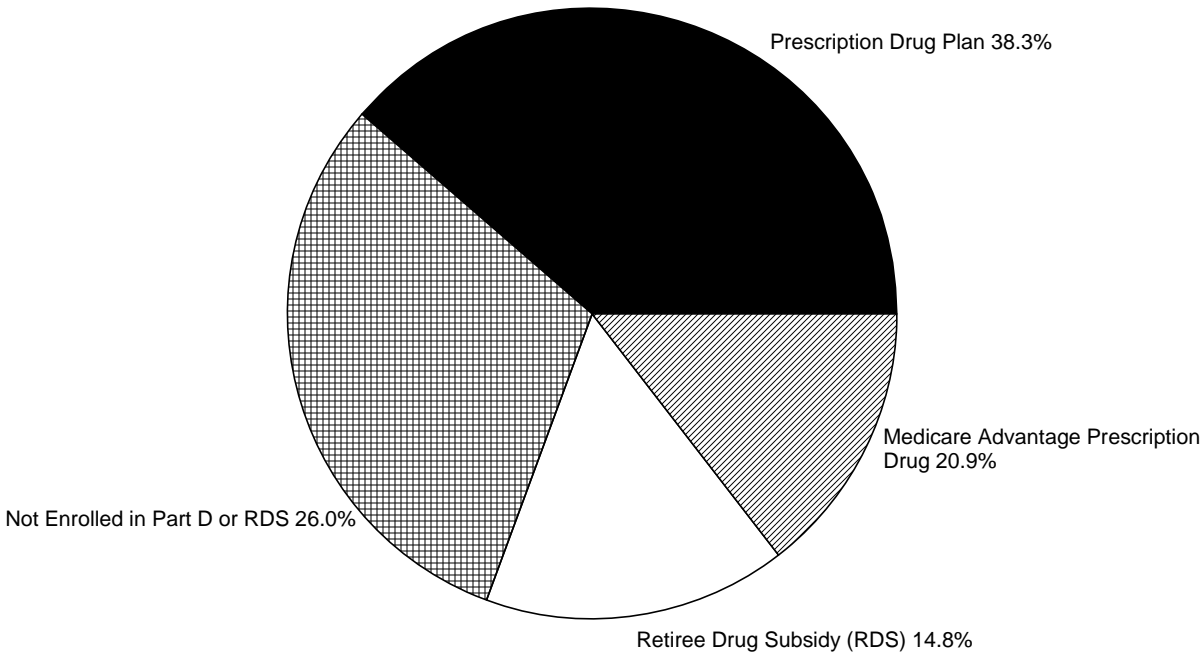

December 2009

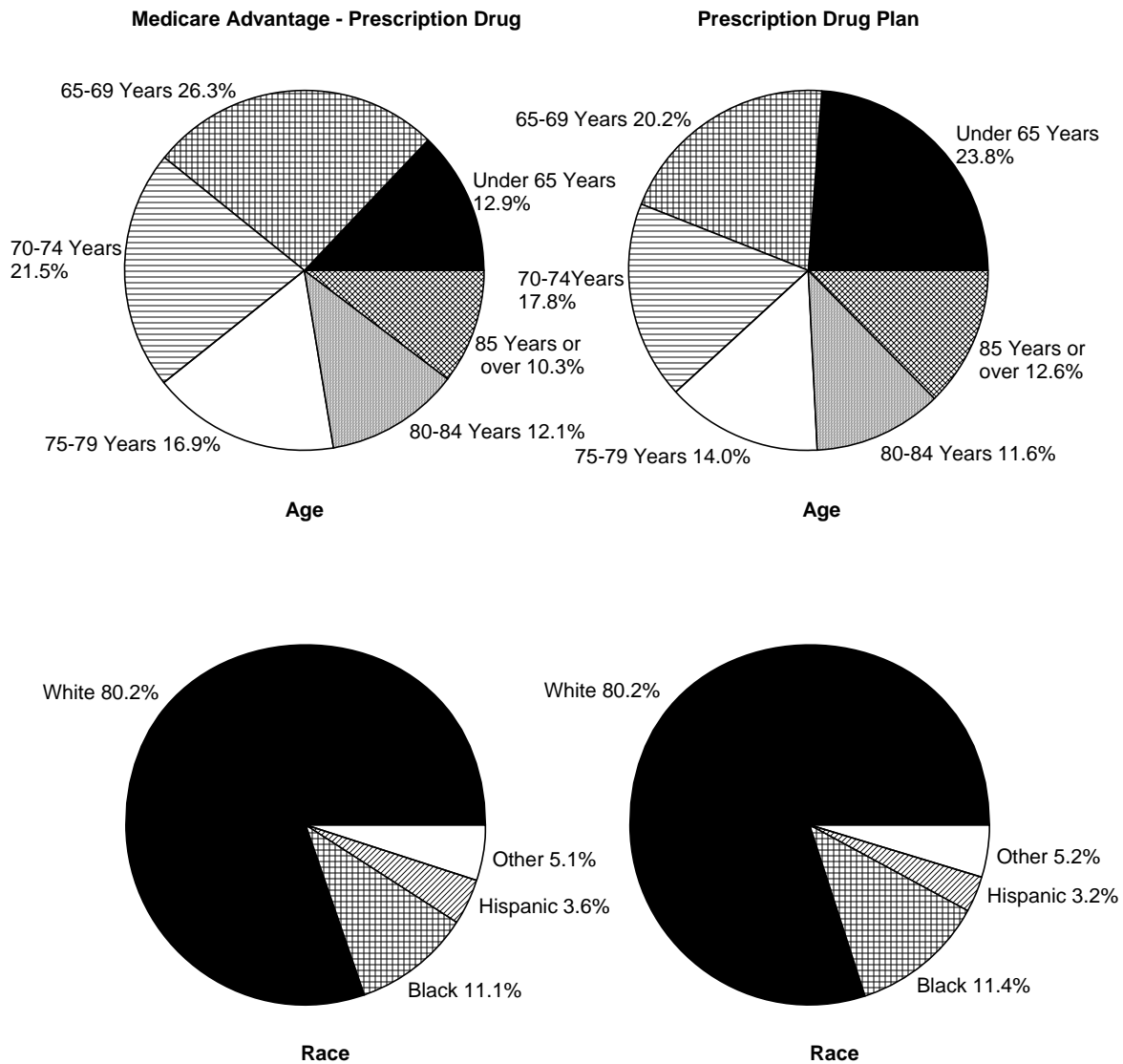

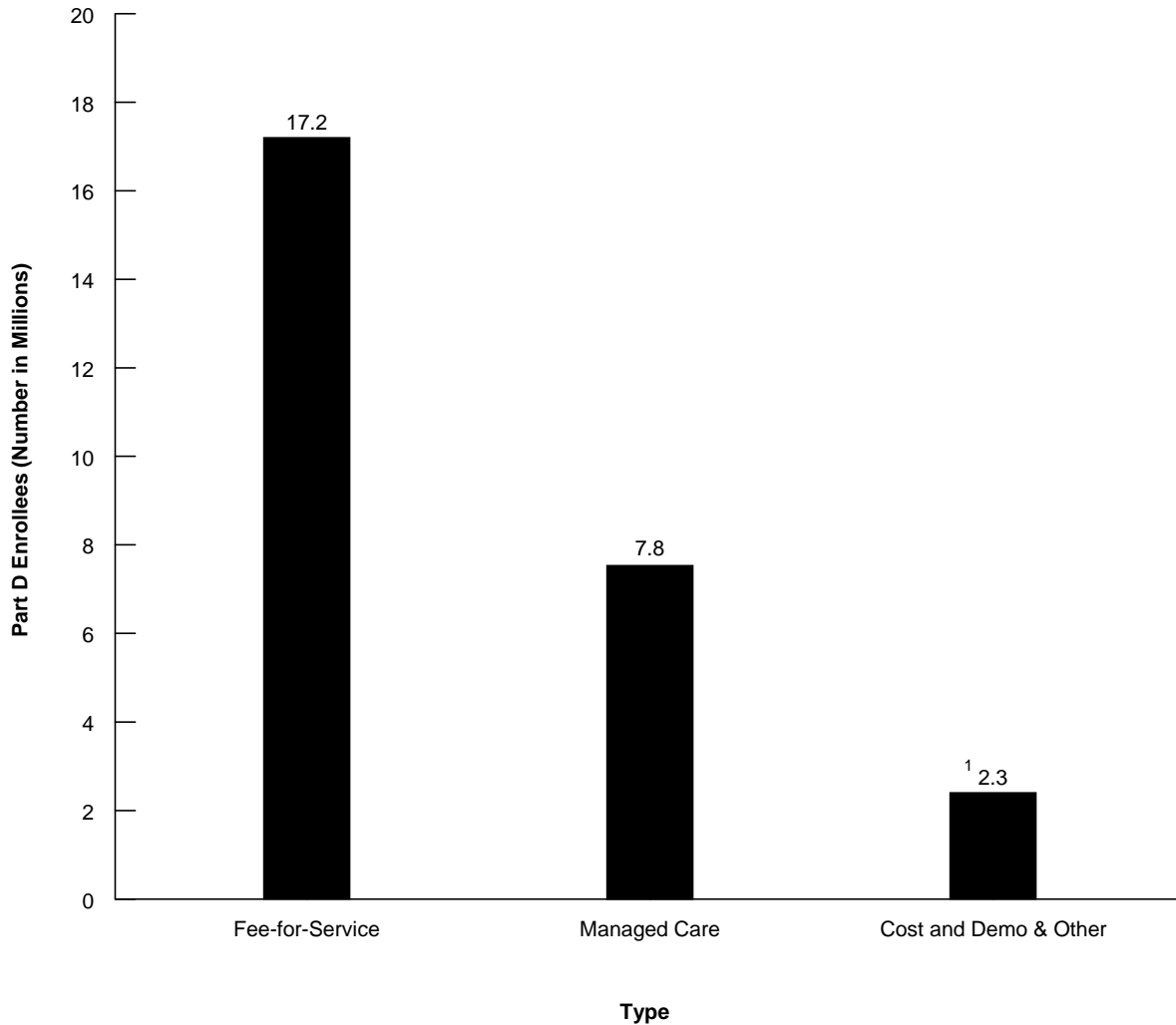
Figure 14.2 Medicare Part D Percent Distribution of Enrollees, by Type of Plan and Demographic Characteristics: December 2009

for Part D Enrollees: December 2009

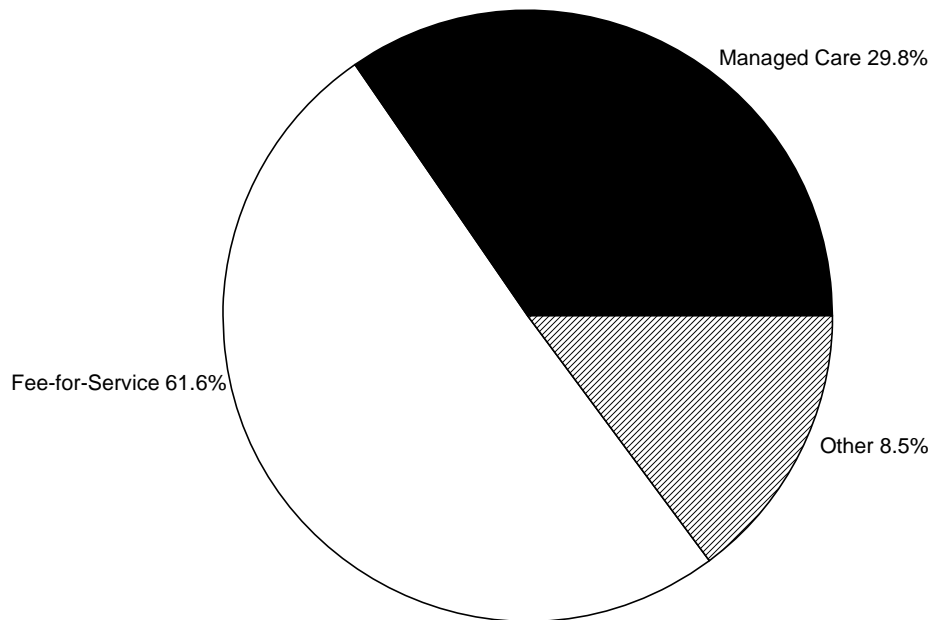
