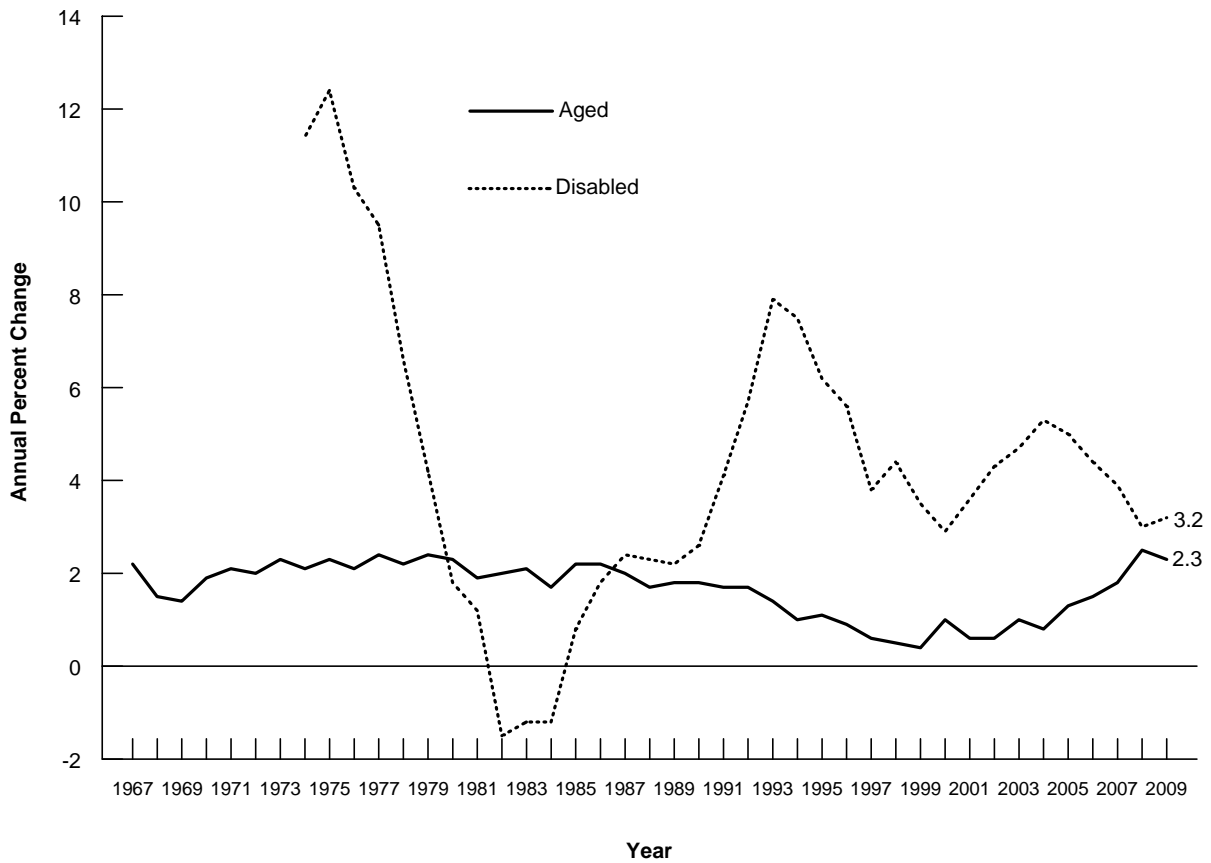

### Annual Percent Change in Number of Medicare Aged and Disabled Enrollees: Calendar Years 1967-2009

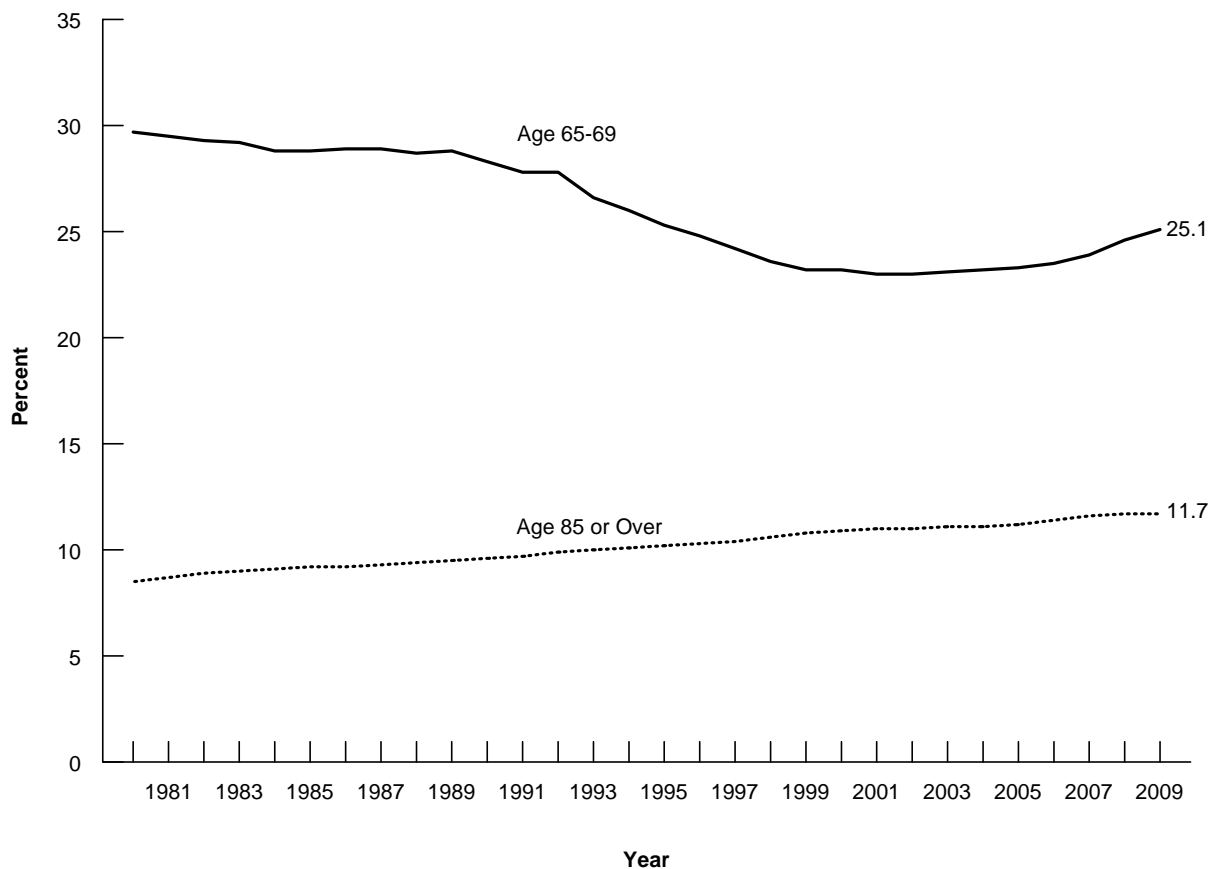

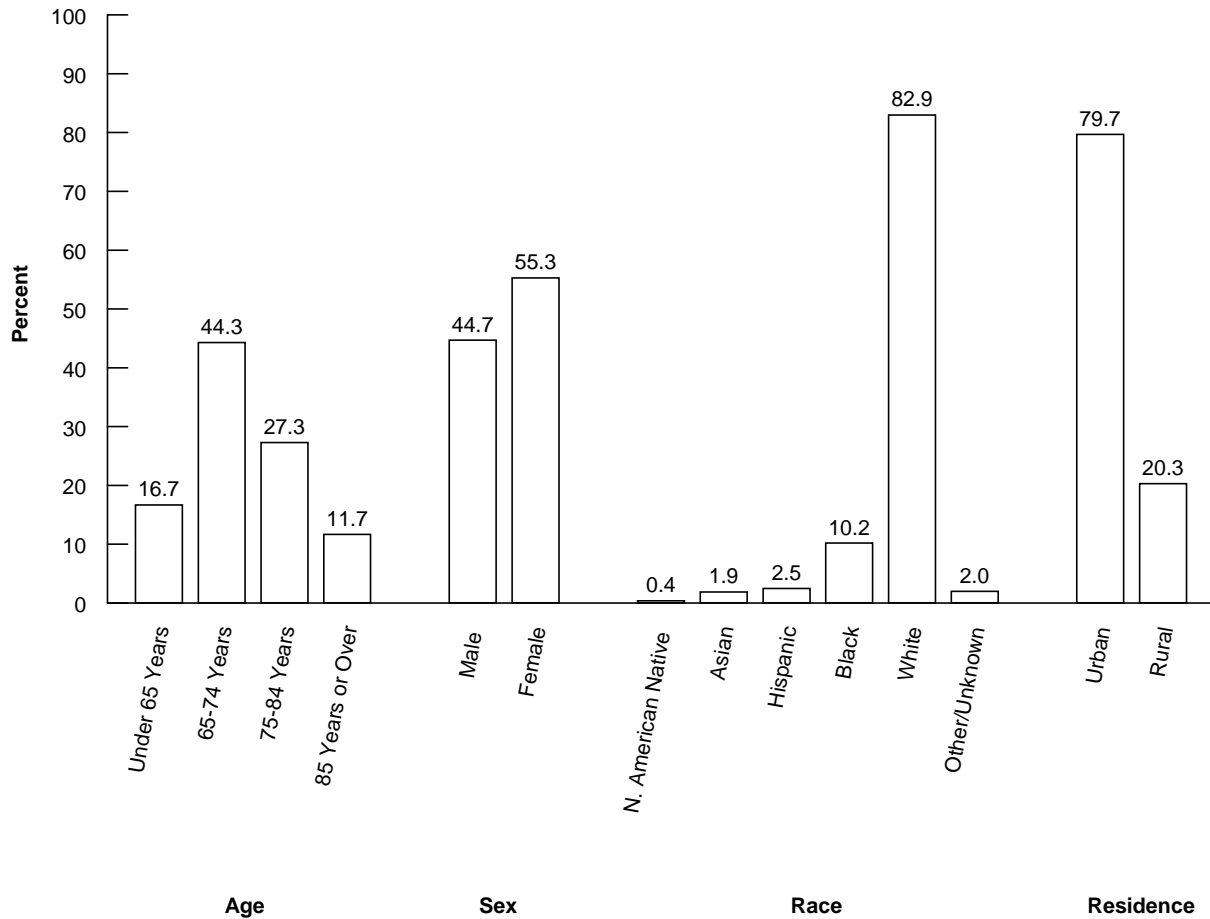
## Figure 2.2
