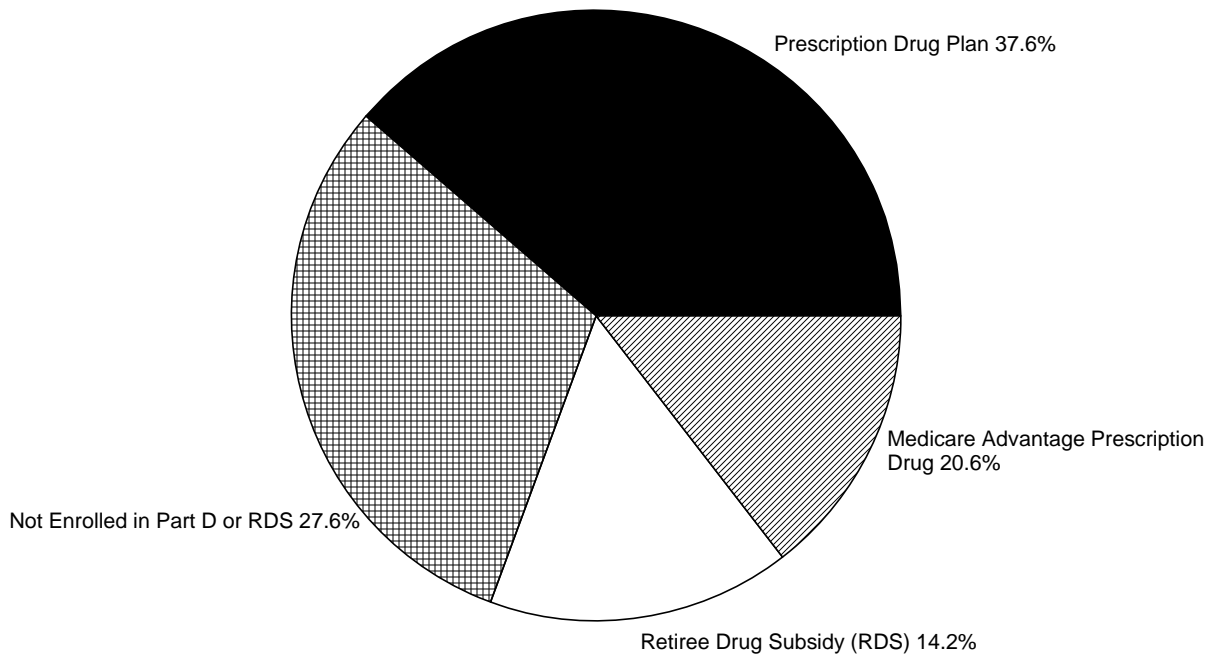

July 1, 2010



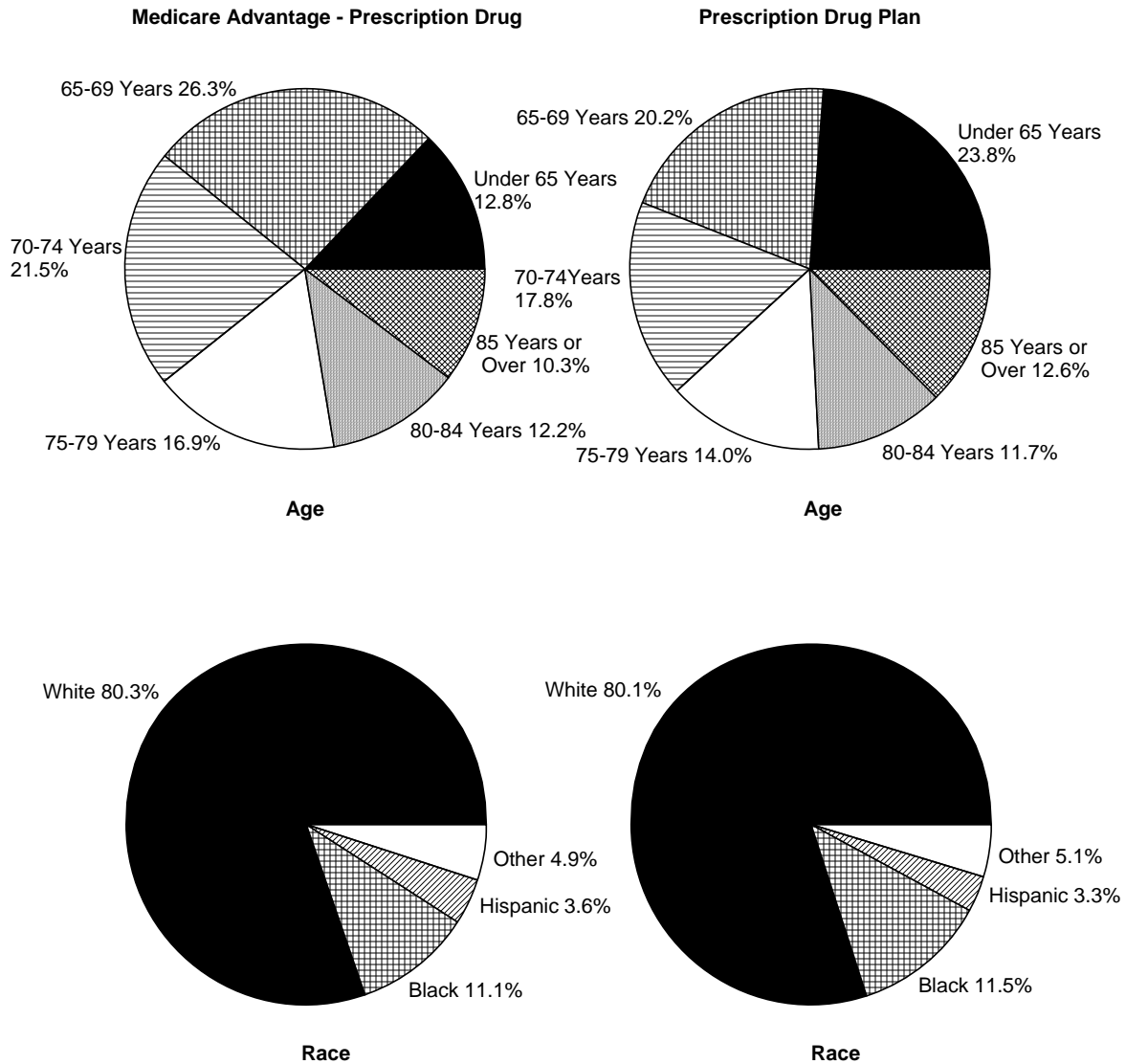

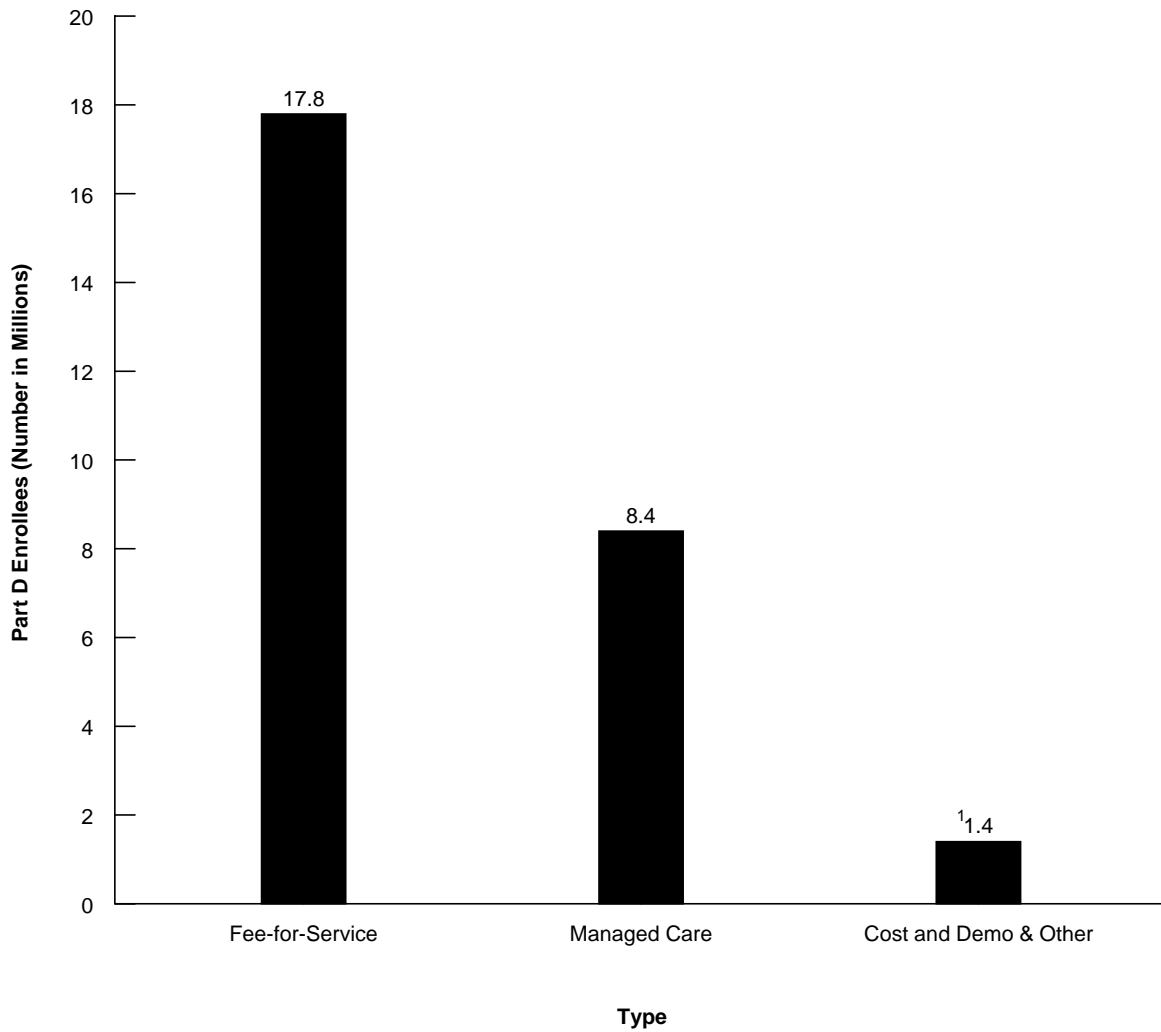
Medicare Part D Percent Distribution of Enrollees, by Type of Plan and Demographic Characteristics: July 1, 2010

for Part D Enrollees: July 1, 2010

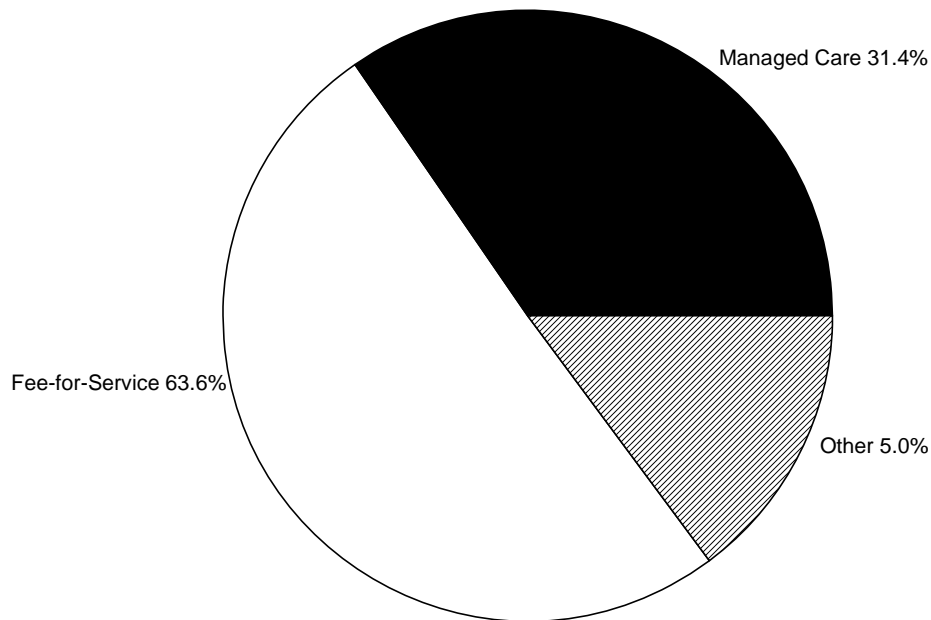
