Background

- We are looking to procure (50) folding tables that will be heavily used for various events throughout the Central Office Facility. The current tables are over 20 years old and have exceeded their use.

Specifications

- Table top size needs to be 24" x 60".
- Table height should have 1" increment height adjustability range from 29" to 36".
- Tabletop core should be ¾" solid particleboard or plywood.
- Tabletop finish should be high pressure laminate that is scratch resistant.
- The edge should be black polyvinyl bullnose.
- Legs should be recessed to allow for unencumbered seating at table ends.
- Legs should be made of 18 gauge steel.
- Leg brace should be made of steel and can easily fold and lock legs into place.
- Leg feet should be capped with non-mar floor glides.
- Steel apron should be 2.25", surround the underside of the table and have no sharp edges.
- Tables need to fold easily and can be stored on a flat loaded table truck.
- Table should weigh no more than 80lbs.
- Table should ship fully assembled.
- Laminate, adhesive, backer board and core material tested to GREENGUARD Air quality standards.
- Table should have at least a 15 year warranty.
