On August 22, 2018, the Department of Health & Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Maryland's State Innovation Waiver under Section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). Maryland's approved application waives the ACA's requirement for the single risk pool to the extent necessary to implement a state reinsurance program called the Maryland State Reinsurance Program for plan years 2019 through 2023.

It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that Maryland's pass-through funding amount for calendar year 2023 is \$473,027,855, which must be used for purposes of implementing Maryland's State Innovation Waiver.
