Dear Director Weeks:

On January 10, 2025, the Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Nevada's State Innovation Waiver under Section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). Nevada's approved application waives the ACA's requirement for the single risk pool to the extent necessary to implement a state reinsurance program in the individual market as part of the Market Stabilization Program, and to implement Battle Born State Plans in the individual market for plan years 2026 through 2030.

It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that Nevada's pass-through funding amount for calendar year 2026 is \$28,914,674, which must be used for purposes of implementing Nevada's State Innovation Waiver.
