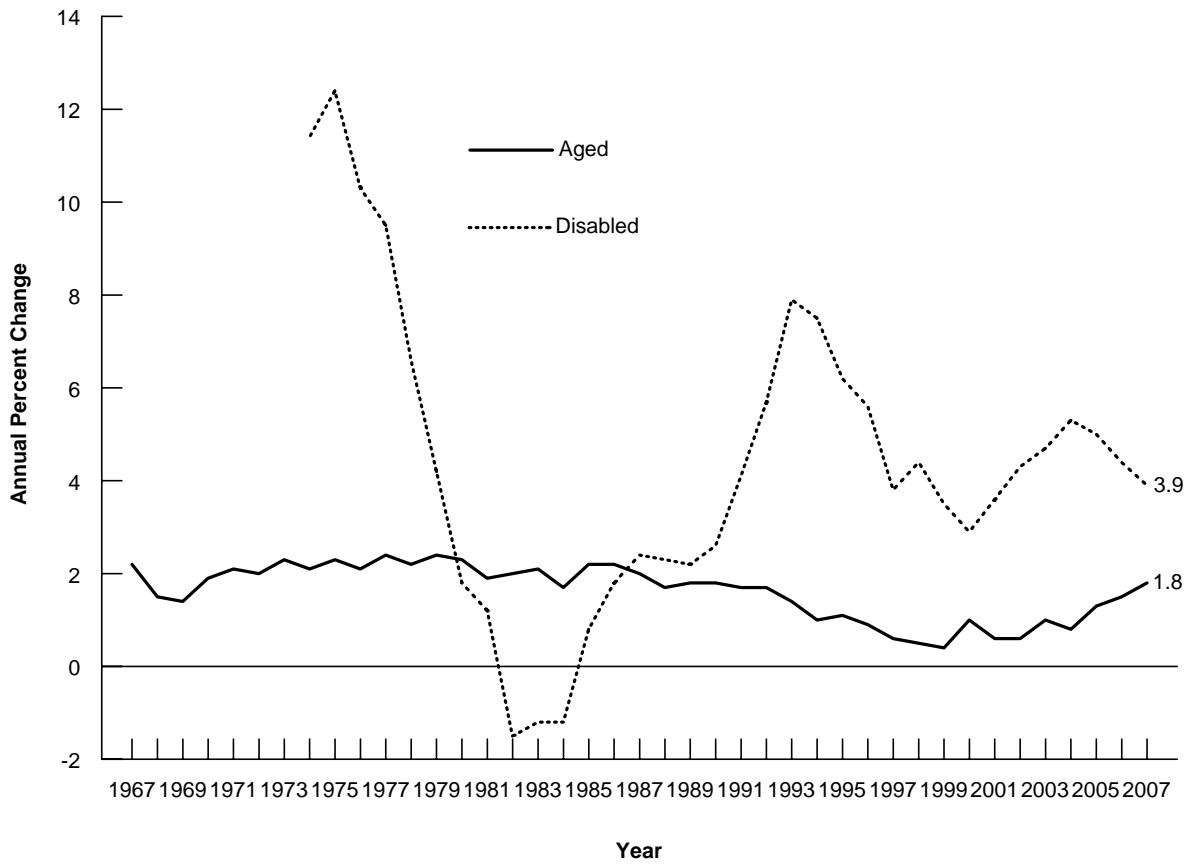

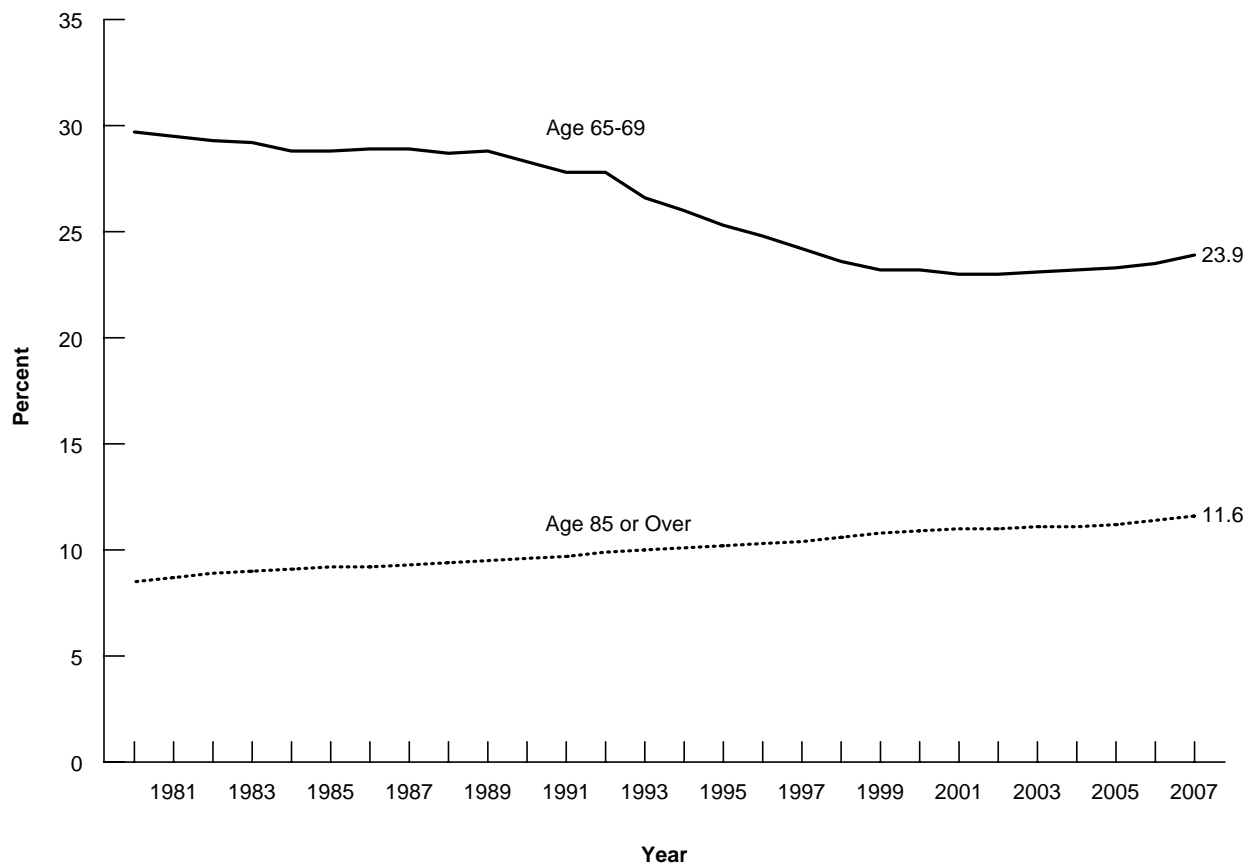
Annual Percent Change in Number of Medicare Aged and Disabled Enrollees: Calendar Years 1967-2007

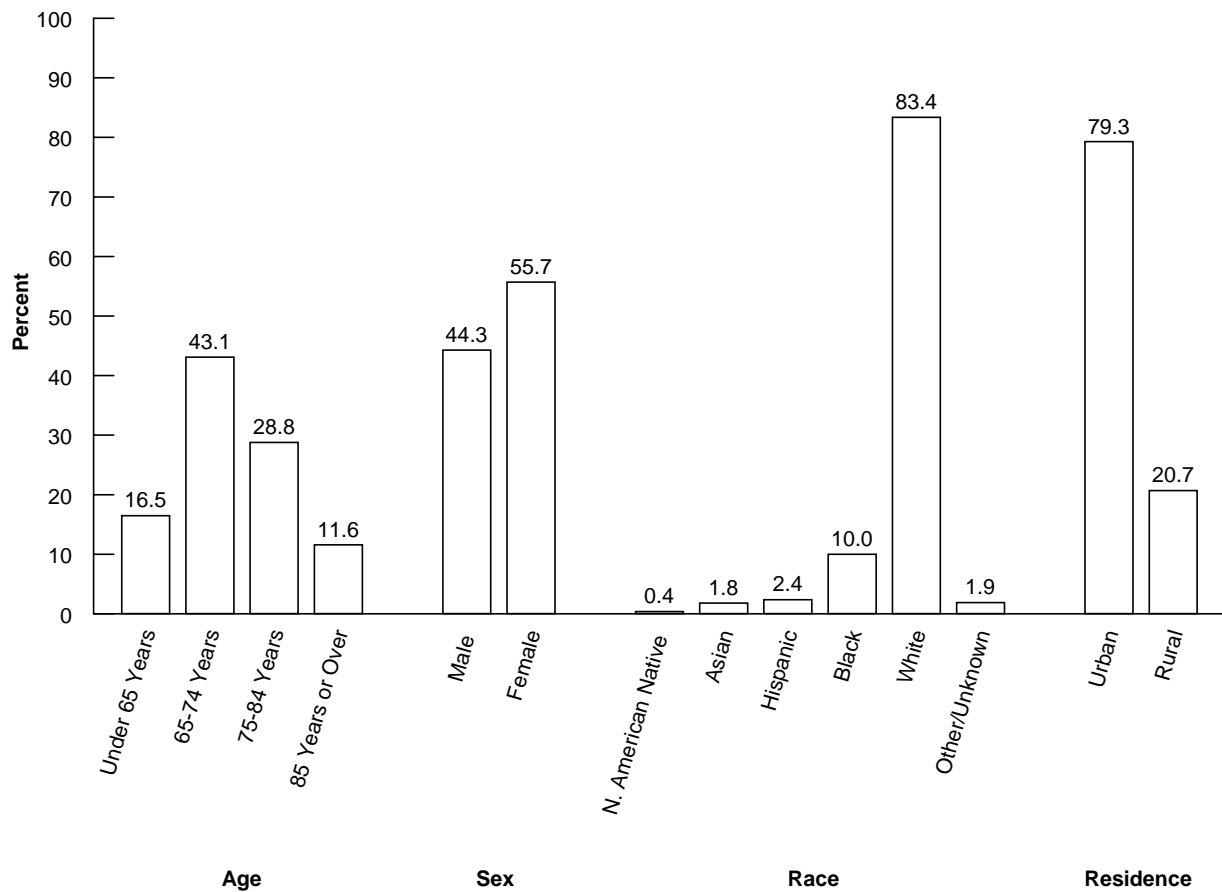
