- View Regulatory Agendas that list regulations each agency plans to issue

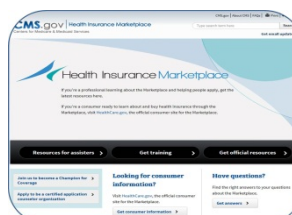


ECFR.gpoaccess.gov
