The initial Call for TEP nomination period closed on November 2, 2018. Supplemental nominations were solicited by October 9, 2019, to fill select vacancies.

Project Overview:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has contracted with Health Services Advisory Group, Inc. (HSAG) to conduct a triennial assessment of the quality and efficiency impact of endorsed measures used in Medicare programs and report the findings to the public in the *National Impact Assessment of CMS Quality Measures Report* (Impact Assessment Report). The contract name is the Measure & Instrument Development and Support (MIDS) Contract. The contract number is HHSM-500-2013-13007I; HHSM-500-T0002. As required by its contract with CMS, HSAG is convening a group of stakeholders and experts to contribute thoughtful input on the development of the fourth triennial report, scheduled for release in 2021. The TEP will meet jointly with the Federal Assessment Steering Committee appointed by CMS.
