Reminder of Upcoming Data Submission Deadline

The submission deadline for the Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Quality Reporting Program (QRP) is approaching. IRF-Patient Assessment Instrument (PAI) assessment data and data submitted via the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) for January 1 – March 31 (Quarter 1) of Calendar Year (CY) 2022 is due with this submission deadline.

All data must be submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. on August 15, 2022.

It is recommended that the applicable Internet Quality Improvement and Evaluation System (iQIES) reports and NHSN analysis reports are run prior to each quarterly reporting deadline to ensure that all required data were submitted. We encourage you to verify all facility information prior to submission, including Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Certification Number (CCN) and facility name.

IRF PPS for Federal FY 2023 and Updates to the IRF QRP (CMS-1767-F).

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) issued a final rule (CMS-1767-F) that updates Medicare payment policies and rates for facilities under the Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Prospective Payment System (PPS) and the IRF Quality Reporting Program (QRP) for fiscal year (FY) 2023. CMS is publishing this final rule consistent with the legal requirements to update Medicare payment policies for IRFs on an annual basis. CMS is also finalizing a policy to expand the IRF quality data reporting requirements under the IRF Quality Reporting Program (QRP) and summarizes comments from stakeholders on Requests for Information (RFI) on the inclusion of a new Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) digital outcome quality measure as well as the CMS health equity strategy for the IRF QRP. IRF QRP: Non-Compliance Notifications

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notifications to Inpatient Rehabilitation Facilities (IRFs) that were determined to be out of compliance with IRF Quality Reporting Program (QRP) requirements for calendar year (CY) 2021, which will affect their fiscal year (FY) 2023 Annual Increase Factor (AIF). Non-compliance notifications will be distributed by the Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) and will be placed into facilities' My Reports folders in Internet Quality Improvement and Evaluation System (iQIES) on July 13, 2022. Facilities that receive a letter of non-compliance may submit a request for reconsideration to CMS via email no later than 11:59 pm, August 11, 2022. If you receive a notice of non-compliance and would like to request a reconsideration, see the instructions in your notification letter and on the IRF Quality Reporting Reconsideration and Exception & Extension webpage.

Please note: Any reconsideration containing protected health information (PHI) will not be processed. All PHI must be removed in order for a reconsideration to be reviewed.

CMS IRF-PAI Quarterly Q&As, June 2022, Consolidated June 2020 to June 2022

IRF Provider Preview Reports - Now Available

The Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Provider Preview Reports have been updated and are now available. These reports contain provider performance scores for quality measures, which will be published on <u>Care Compare</u> and <u>Provider Data Catalog (PDC)</u> during the **September 2022** release.

Please note that historically, in any given calendar year the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) performs the annual update to all IRF claims-based quality measures during the September refresh of the Care Compare/Provider Data Catalog sites. Because CMS only recently resumed public reporting of IRF claims-based measures during the June 2022 refresh, we will not be performing the normal annual update in September, as the data will not change enough to be meaningful. CMS will next update these IRF measures during the September 2023 update, after which we will resume our normal cadence of annual updates.
