

2026-2027 CMS Navigator Cooperative Agreement Awardees

Since 2013, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has awarded funding to organizations serving as Navigators in states with a Federally-facilitated Exchange (FFE). Funded organizations operate as Navigators year-round, using funding from CMS to conduct outreach and education in their communities. They raise awareness among uninsured consumers about the coverage options available to them, help consumers find affordable coverage that meets their needs, and assist them beyond the enrollment process. Entities and individuals cannot serve as federally certified Navigators without receiving federal cooperative agreement funding from CMS, authorized in the Affordable Care Act, to perform Navigator duties.

The 2024 Navigator cooperative agreement awards were awarded for a five-year period of performance, which runs from August 27, 2024 through August 26, 2029. The cooperative agreement award amounts listed below under each awardee cover the third 12-month budget period (August 27, 2026 to August 26, 2027). Awardees marked with an asterisk (*) have been funded to work in more than one FFE state and are listed separately under each FFE state they are funded to work in.
