Public Reporting December 2025 Refresh of IRF QRP Data – Now Available

The **December 2025** refresh of the IRF QRP is now available on the compare tool on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) and [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](#).

This public reporting refresh includes the removal of the **COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage among Healthcare Personnel (HCP)** measure and the **COVID-19 Vaccine: Percent of Patients/Residents Who Are Up to Date** measure. Older data for these measures will continue to be available in the [IRF archived data snapshots](#) on PDC. The December 2025 refresh includes:

- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) measures reflecting data from **Quarter 1, 2024 through Quarter 4, 2024** for the Clostridium Difficile Infection (CDI) and Catheter-Associated Urinary Tract Infections (CAUTI) measures.
- The Influenza Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel measure reflecting data from **Quarter 4, 2024 through Quarter 1, 2025**.
- Claims-based measures reflecting data from **Quarter 4, 2022 through Quarter 3, 2024**.

IRF Provider Preview Reports – Now Available

The Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Provider Preview Reports have been updated and are now available. These reports contain provider performance scores for quality measures, which will be published on the compare tool on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) and the [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](#) during the **March 2026 refresh**.

The Preview Reports for the March 2026 release include:

- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) **Clostridium Difficile Infection (CDI) and Catheter-Associated Urinary Tract Infections (CAUTI)** measures reflect data from **Quarter 2, 2024 through Quarter 1, 2025.**
- **The Healthcare Personnel (HCP) Influenza measure based on data from Quarter 4, 2024 through Quarter 1, 2025.**
- The claims-based measures based on data from **Quarter 4, 2022 through Quarter 3, 2024.**

Providers have until **January 14, 2026** to review their performance data. Only updates/corrections to the underlying assessment data before the final data submission deadline will be reflected in the publicly reported data on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) and the [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](https://www.cms.gov/provider-data). If a provider updates assessment data after the final data submission deadline, the updated data will only be reflected in the Facility-Level Quality Measure (QM) report and Patient-Level QM report. Updates submitted after the final data submission deadline will not be reflected in the Provider Preview Reports or on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov). IRF Quality Reporting Program: Reopening of September 2025 Preview Period

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has updated the Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Provider Preview Reports, which are now available for provider review. These revised reports contain corrected provider performance scores for quality measures that will be published on the compare tool on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) and the [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](https://www.cms.gov/provider-data) during the September 2025 refresh.

Important Update: CMS identified and resolved technical issues that affected the following quality measure calculations in the initial September 2025 preview data:

- IRF Discharge Function
- IRF Discharge Self-care
- IRF Discharge Mobility

The updated reports reflect the most accurate performance data and ensure the integrity of publicly reported quality measures.

The Preview Reports for the **September 2025** release include:

- **The assessment-based measures based on** quality assessment data submitted by IRFs from **Quarter 1, 2024 through Quarter 4, 2024.**
- **The new COVID-19 Vaccine: Percent of Patients/Residents Who Are Up to Date** measure based on quality assessment data from **Quarter 4, 2024.**
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) **Clostridium Difficile Infection (CDI) and Catheter-Associated Urinary Tract Infections (CAUTI)** measures based on data from **Quarter 4, 2023 through Quarter 3, 2024.**
- **The Healthcare Personnel (HCP) Influenza** measure based on data from **Quarter 4, 2023 through Quarter 1, 2024.**
- The **COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage among Healthcare Personnel (HCP)** measure based on data from **Quarter 4, 2024.**
- The **claims-based measures** based on data from **Quarter 4, 2021 through Quarter 3, 2023.** These measures will be refreshed in December 2025.

Providers have until **August 28, 2025**, to review their updated performance data. Only updates/corrections to the underlying assessment data before the final data submission deadline will be reflected in the publicly reported data on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) and the [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](#). If a provider updates assessment data after the final data submission deadline, the updated data will only be reflected in the Facility-Level Quality Measure (QM) report and Patient-Level QM report. Updates submitted after the final data submission deadline will not be reflected in the Provider Preview Reports or on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov). However, providers can request Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) review of their data during the preview period if they believe the quality measure scores that are displayed within their Preview Reports are inaccurate.

The Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Provider Preview Reports have been updated and are now available.
