If a provider updates assessment data after the final data submission deadline, the updated data will only be reflected in the Facility-Level Quality Measure (QM) report and Patient-Level QM report. Updates submitted after the final data submission deadline will not be reflected in the Provider Preview Reports or on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov). However, providers can request a CMS review of their data during the preview period if they believe the displayed quality measure scores within their Provider Preview Reports are inaccurate.

LTCH Quality Reporting Program: Reopening of the September 2025 Preview Period

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has updated the Long-Term Care Hospital (LTCH) Provider Preview Reports, which are now available for provider review. These revised reports contain corrected provider performance scores for quality measures that will be published on the compare tool on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) and the [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](#) during the September 2025 refresh.

Important Update: CMS identified and resolved technical issues that affected the following quality measure calculations in the initial September 2025 preview data:

- LTCH Discharge Function

The updated reports reflect the most accurate performance data and ensure the integrity of publicly reported quality measures.

The Preview Reports for the September 2025 release include:

- **The assessment-based measures based on** quality assessment data submitted by LTCHs from **Quarter 1, 2024 through Quarter 4, 2024**. The **LTCH Change in Mobility** measure is based on data from **Quarter 1, 2023 through Quarter 4, 2024**.

- **The new COVID-19 Vaccine: Percent of Patients/Residents Who Are Up to Date** measure based on quality assessment data from **Quarter 4, 2024**.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) **Clostridium Difficile Infection (CDI)**, **Catheter-Associated Urinary Tract Infections (CAUTI)**, and **Central Line-Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSI)** measures based on data from **Quarter 4, 2023 through Quarter 3, 2024**.
- The **Healthcare Personnel (HCP) Influenza** measure based on data from **Quarter 4, 2023 through Quarter 1, 2024**.
- The **COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage among Healthcare Personnel (HCP)** measure based on data from **Quarter 4, 2024**.
- The **claims-based measures** based on data from **Quarter 4, 2021 through Quarter 3, 2023**. These measures will be refreshed in December 2025.

Providers have until **August 28, 2025**, to review their performance data. Only updates/corrections to the underlying assessment data before the final data submission deadline will be reflected in the publicly reported data on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) and the [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](#). If a provider updates assessment data after the final data submission deadline, the updated data will only be reflected in the Facility-Level Quality Measure (QM) report and Patient-Level QM report. Updates submitted after the final data submission deadline will not be reflected in the Provider Preview Reports or on [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov).
