

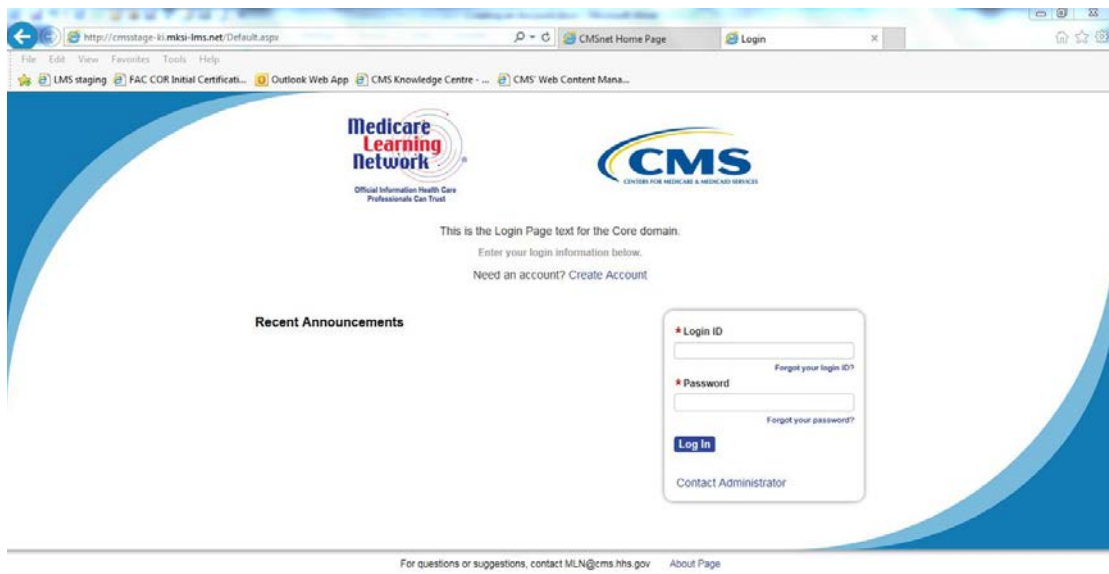
# How Learners Can Access a WBT

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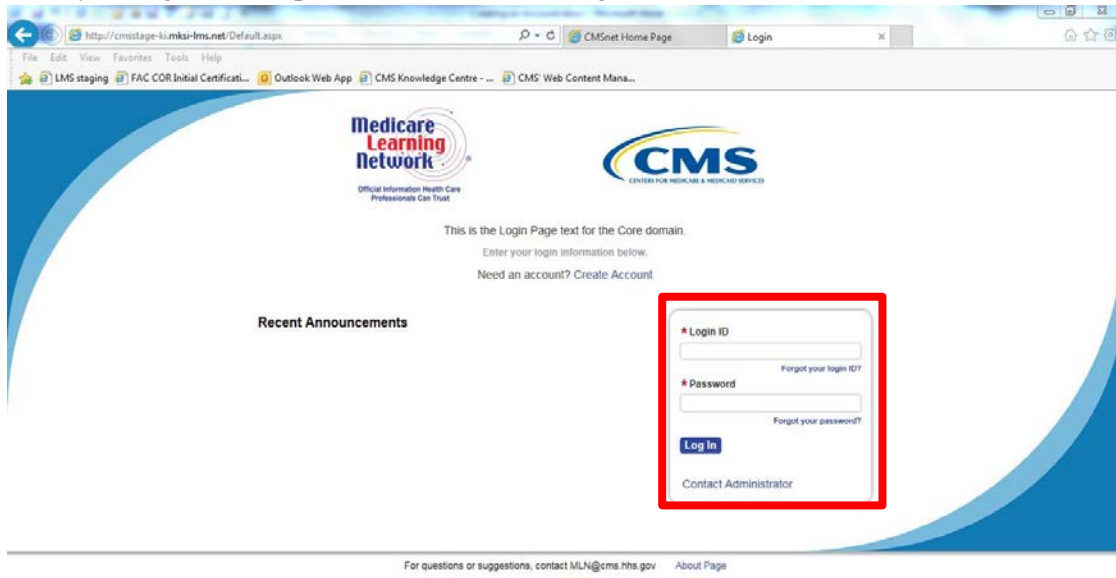
1. Go to the LM/POS Homepage <https://learner.mlnlms.com>
2. Enter your login ID and password and click on Log In
3. Click on Training Catalog
4. Enter search criteria in the “search for” box and click “search” or select the item from the drop down menu
5. Select the title of the WBT
6. Click on “Enroll”
7. Select “Credit” or “No Credit” and choose a course mode option and click “Enroll”
8. Click on “Open Item”
9. Take the course!

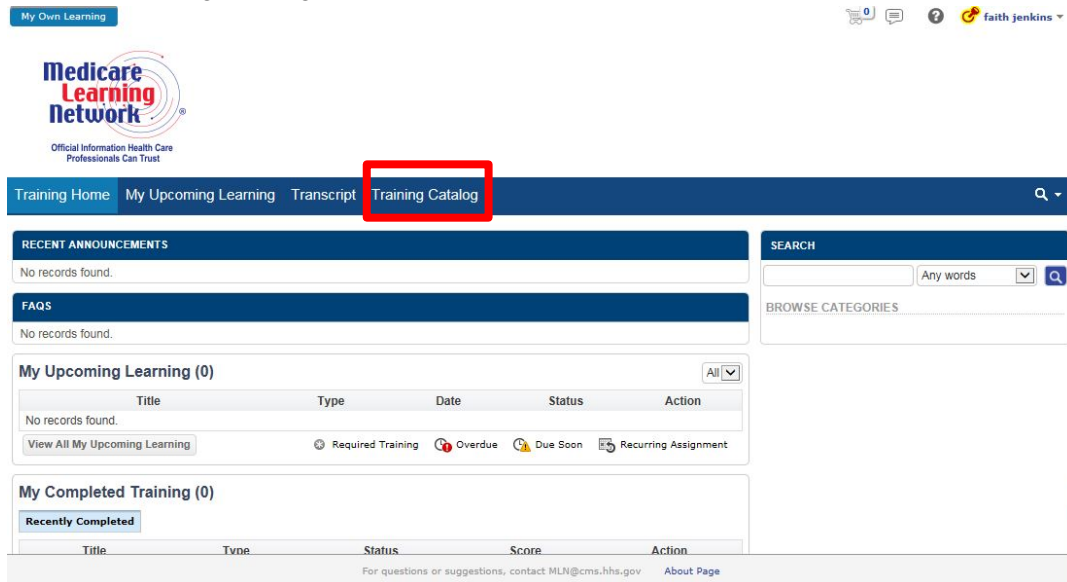




