

AMA Exhibit 11: PCPI Measures Amendment Terms and Conditions

Physician Consortium for Performance Improvement (PCPI) Separate License Agreement

The AMA and CMS have signed a Data Rights Agreement providing CMS a license in specified Physician Performance Measurement Sets (“PPMS”) developed by the Physician Consortium for Performance Improvement (“The Consortium”).

The Consortium was formed to establish Measure(s) for various medical conditions to assist physicians in providing medical quality care. The Data Rights Agreement sets forth the following terms and conditions:

1. The following CMS files may be added to the CMS files that may display CPT in electronic media
 - a. Adult Diabetes
 - b. Asthma
 - c. Chronic Stable Coronary Heart Disease
 - d. Heart Failure
 - e. Hypertension
 - f. Major Depressive Disorder
 - g. Osteoarthritis of the Knee
 - h. Prenatal Testing, Preventative Care and Screening
 - i. Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease
2. The Measures may include CPT 5-character codes and 2-character modifiers only and not descriptions.
3. CMS will give authorship of the PPMS to the Consortium and its members and will include AMA’s copyright notices and disclaimers, in any publications, public displays, or distributions of PPMS.
4. The formats of presentation of CPT in Measures shall be in accordance with the following examples listed in AMA Exhibit 12 and shall include the copyright and other notices and disclaimers as approved by the AMA.
