

AMA Exhibit 22: EDGE Server Software System CPT Use Terms and Conditions

The American Medical Association (AMA) and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) have signed an amendment to the AMA-CMS Original Licensing Agreement and subsequent Electronic Agreement authorizing use of CPT in the EDGE Server Software System.

EDGE Server Software System

CMS may use CPT in the EDGE Server Software System for the **Reinsurance and Risk Adjustment Affordable Care Act Premium Stabilization Programs** under the following Terms, Conditions, and Restrictions.

A. Terms and Conditions

- (1) The Edge Server may include CPT five (5) digit codes and CPT modifiers only, not descriptions.
- (2) Any display of CPT in the Edge Server, including displays viewed by the database administrator, will be preceded by the following copyright notice: *CPT® only copyright 2013 American Medical Association. All rights reserved.*
- (3) CMS will update the licenses annually to include the updated year of the CPT publication.

B. Restrictions

The AMA acknowledges CPT codes are generally not displayed for Edge Server users while the Edge Server Database Administrator's root access gives the Database Administrator full access to the complete set of CPT reference data.

Notwithstanding the above, the AMA **restricts** CMS CPT Edge Server use as follows:

- (1) The Database Administrator may not view CPT codes under standard Edge Server operations.
- (2) The Database Administrator may only view required CPT codes by searching the Edge Server.
- (3) Under normal operating conditions, the Database Administrator only views CPT codes that appear on inbound claims and detailed output reports.
