Notice to Public of Termination of **HOSPICE AND PALLIATIVE CARE OF CALIFORNIA, INC**

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has determined that Hospice and Palliative Care of California, Inc. CCN# B31589 has failed to substantially comply with Medicare and Medicaid health and safety participation requirements. Notice is hereby given that on October 9, 2025, in compliance with federal law, CMS will terminate the Medicare provider agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Hospice and Palliative Care of California, Inc.

In addition, Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after October 9, 2025. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to October 9, 2025, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after October 9, 2025, the date of termination.

While we understand the relocation of residents can be challenging for all parties involved, CMS prioritizes resident safety and care quality. We are closely monitoring the relocation of residents to other facilities.
