**LEGAL NOTICE OF  
TERMINATION FROM MEDICARE PROGRAM**

Effective on November 1, 2024, the Secretary of the Department of Health & Human Services will terminate its Medicare Provider Agreement with Spectrum Hospice, Inc. at 1925 West Glenoaks Blvd. Glendale, California, 91201. This action is being taken because the hospice agency has not corrected the findings from their February 23, 2024, Medicare complaint validation survey which found noncompliance with requirements for participation in the Medicare and Medicaid programs as established by the Social Security Act (Section 1861) and its underlying regulations.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has determined that Spectrum Hospice, Inc. was not in compliance with the following three (3) Medicare Conditions of Participation for Hospice Agencies under 42 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) Part 418:

- 42 C.F.R. § 418.54 Initial & Comprehensive Assessment of Patient
- 42 C.F.R. § 418.56 Interdisciplinary Group, Care Planning, and Coordination of Services
- 42 C.F.R. § 418.102 Medical Director

Medicare and Medicaid programs will not make payments for services furnished to patients who were admitted on or after November 1, 2024. For patients admitted prior to November 1, 2024, payment may be available for up to thirty (30) calendar days after the effective date of termination.
