DISPUTE FILE

Dispute files must be sent to the filename noted. Please note that there is no electronic dispute file response. The trading partner's technical contact will receive an email notification acknowledging receipt of any submitted dispute file. Once the file has been processed, an email response will be sent to the same individual.
