SUBJECT: Michigan AIP D-SNPs: Updates to Contract Year 2027 Model Materials

CMS and the state of Michigan have revised the Member ID Card and Member Handbook CY 2027 models for use by applicable integrated plan (AIP) dual eligible special needs plans (D-SNPs) operating in Michigan. The updated models, which accompany this memorandum, replace the models previously issued on June 8, 2026. Plans should update these materials prior to submission to CMS and the state of Michigan for review in HPMS. Plans that have previously submitted these materials for review must resubmit the updated versions.

These updates include:

- **Member ID Card**
 - Added the Medicaid beneficiary ID number if it is different from the member ID number
 - The care coordinator number is optional
 - The language stating member cannot be charged is now required
 - Added instruction noting that plans have the option to use the Rx Prescription Issuer Identification Number (RxIIN) number in place of the RxBIN number.
 - Added dental vendor phone number on back of the card
 - NEMT number is now required on the back of the card
 - Added instructions regarding phone numbers on the back of the card
- **Member Handbook**
 - Chapter 1, Section E, pages 10-12- updated eligibility information and deeming language
 - Chapter 2, Section A, page 4- updated the Michigan Community, Home and Health

- Chapter 4 pages, Section C, pages 5-6- updated deeming language
- Chapter 10 pages, Section E, pages 9-11- updated deeming language
