






8) Select 2048-bit RSA in the Key Algorithm drop-down, figure 6



9) Enter the file location and password for the digital Id file



10) The "Sign Document" window reappears, from the "Appearance" drop-down, select




11) In the "Configure Signature Appearance" window, select Import graphic, File, figure 8
