Re: Elevance Health, Inc. Corrective Action Progress – Step 2

Dear Ms. Dailey:

On May 28, 2026, CMS received Elevance Health Inc.'s attestation, as required in Step 2 of Attachment 3 – Corrective Action Steps\_REVISED\_04102026, stating Elevance has:

- Completed the initial submission in CMS's established electronic systems: Risk Adjustment Processing System (RAPS), the Encounter Data Processing System (EDPS), and the Risk Adjustment Overpayment Reporting (RAOR) module; and
- Remitted a wire transfer of the total overpayment amount based on all auditable estimates related to this matter, as reported in RAOR, and uploaded spreadsheets showing each Overpayment ID and the auditable estimate amount for that ID to the HPMS CAM.

Based on the attestation, CMS will not impose intermediate sanctions at this time.

As a reminder, Elevance must complete the tasks described in Steps 3 and 4 of Attachment 3 by June 30, 2026, to avoid intermediate sanctions effective July 1, 2026.

Further, any incomplete tasks, and the following remaining tasks described in Step 2, must be completed by July 31, 2026, to avoid intermediate sanctions effective August 1, 2026:

- Resolving any issues raised during CMS technical assistance on RAOR submissions and any submission of additional overpayment amounts identified as a result of that technical assistance, including the upload to HPMS CAM of an updated spreadsheet as described in *Appendix B: Remit the total overpayment*;
- Resolving all rejections, errors, and edits identified by CMS on standard RAPS and EDPS reports; and

- Submitting Attestation 2.
