All	Beneficiary Pays	Update column to reflect "copayment/coinsurance" instead of only "copayment".
Smoking and Tobacco-Use Cessation Counseling	All	Add new service to the chart.
Screening Pap Tests	ICD-9-CM Codes	Add diagnosis code V72.31, effective 7/1/05 (see CR 3659).
Pelvic Screening Exam	Service	Change to "Screening Pelvic Exam".
Pelvic Screening Exam	ICD-9-CM Codes	Add diagnosis code V72.31, effective 7/1/05 (see CR 3659).
Mammography Screening	Service	Change to "Screening Mammography".
Mammography Screening	HCPCS/CPT Codes	Remove diagnostic codes 76090 and 76091 and delete "(these are the codes for Medicare-covered mammography services)".
Colorectal Cancer Screening	HCPCS/CPT Codes	Add double asterisks to codes G0104, G0105, G0106, G0120, and G0121; add footnote at bottom of page: "***For services furnished prior to January 1, 2007 the deductible and coinsurance apply for these codes. For services furnished on or after January 1, 2007 the deductible will not apply, however, the coinsurance will still apply for these codes." (see CR 5127).
Prostate Cancer Screening	Who Is Covered	Add "(coverage begins the day after 50 <sup>th</sup> birthday)" for DRE and PSA.
Glaucoma Screening	Who Is Covered	Add "or Hispanic-Americans age 65 and older".
Influenza (Flu)	HCPCS/CPT Codes	Add CPT Code 90660 (see CR 5037).
Influenza (Flu)	ICD-9-CM Codes	Add diagnosis code V06.6 for Flu and PPV vaccines when the purpose of the visit was to receive both vaccines, effective 10/1/06 (see CR 5037).
Influenza (Flu)	Frequency	Correct to read: "Once per flu season in the fall or winter" and delete "More frequently if medically necessary".
Pneumococcal	ICD-9-CM Codes	Add diagnosis code V06.6 for PPV and Flu vaccines when the purpose of the visit was to receive both vaccines, effective 10/1/06 (see CR 5037).
Hepatitis B (HBV)	HCPCS/CPT Codes	Correct code 90717 to 90747.
Hepatitis B (HBV)	HCPCS/CPT Codes	Add CPT codes 90471 and 90472 for Administration (OPPS hospitals only), effective 7/1/06 (see CR 4240).
