Notice to the Public of Suspension of Indigo Dermatology, LLC's CLIA Certificate (CLIA Number 10D228476)

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on December 20, 2025, Indigo Dermatology, LLC's CLIA certificate, located at 14499 North Dale Mabry Hwy, Suite 129-S, Tampa, FL 33618, will be suspended due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements. The laboratory was notified on December 5, 2025.

When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is suspended, it is required to cease all patient laboratory testing, including waived and provider-performed microscopy testing regardless of whether or not the laboratory charges for the testing. CMS is committed to patient safety and quality of care.
