Notice to the Public of Revocation and Cancellation to Receive Medicare Payment of Kenneth A. Giraldo MD PA's CLIA Certificate, CLIA Number, 10D1077790

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on **April 9, 2025**, the **Kenneth A. Giraldo MD PA's** CLIA certificate, located at 1219 SE Ave., Ste 101, Sarasota, FL 34239 will be revoked for all patient laboratory testing due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements. In addition, the laboratory's approval to receive Medicare payments will be canceled.

The laboratory was notified on April 9, 2025. When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is revoked, it is required to cease all patient laboratory testing, including waived and provider-performed microscopy testing regardless of whether or not the laboratory charges for the testing. CMS is committed to patient safety and quality of care.
