## **Revised** Notice to Public of De-certification of Life Alliance Organ Recovery Agency (LAORA)

On September 18, 2025, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) notified the public that CMS has determined that Life Alliance Organ Recovery Agency (LAORA) no longer meets the requirements for certification as a qualified organ procurement organization. Notice is hereby given that CMS is extending the effective date of de-certification and termination of LAORA's agreement to March 27, 2026, to allow for the orderly transition of OPO services in the donation service area for LAORA. On March 27, 2026, CMS will terminate the Medicare provider agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Life Alliance Organ Recovery Agency, 1951 NW 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Suite 220, Miami, Florida, and de-certify LAORA as a qualified organ procurement organization.

No Medicare and Medicaid payments will be made with respect to organ procurement costs attributable to LAORA on or after March 27, 2026.

While we understand that this involuntary decertification can be challenging for all parties involved, CMS prioritizes safety and care quality and will work to ensure a smooth transition to another organ procurement organization for this donation service area.
