**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR INVOLUNTARY TERMINATION OF MEDICARE
/MEDICAID PROVIDER AGREEMENT**

Notice is hereby given that effective December 10, 2020, the agreement between Astoria Hospice, 8322 Office Park Drive Unit D, Douglasville, Georgia, 30134 and the Secretary of Health and Human Services, as a provider of Hospice Services in the Health Insurance for the Aged and Disabled Program (Medicare) is to be terminated.

The Medicare program will not make payment for hospice services to patients who are admitted on or after December 10, 2020. For patients admitted prior to December 10, 2020, payment may continue to be made for up to 30 days of services furnished on or after December 10, 2020.
