The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends everyone 6 months and older get a yearly flu shot. A flu shot has many important benefits, including reducing the risk of flu illness, hospitalization, and death.

3 more reasons it's important to get your flu shot:

- Your flu shot is free. Immunization vaccines are a covered preventive care benefit under Medicare, Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).
- While babies, children, and older people are most vulnerable, no one is immune from the flu.
- Getting vaccinated is more important than ever. Getting the shot helps reduce illness and preserve health care resources as the country battles the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) emergency.

According to the CDC, the flu vaccine doesn't increase the risk of getting COVID-19. When you get your shot, try your best to maintain social distancing, avoid waiting areas, and always wear a mask.

The CMS Division of Tribal Affairs has developed a series of materials to educate people about the importance of flu vaccination. They include a print ad, which can be posted in your clinic or published in your local tribal newspaper, a customizable flyer and bookmark that can be used to promote the date and times when flu vaccinations are available, and signature blocks which are a personalized block of text that can be automatically added to your email messages to promote and remind recipients of the importance of flu vaccinations.




Medicare flu print ad


