Termination Notice

Notice is hereby given that on December 31, 2019 the agreement between Precious Nurses Health Care Agency, Inc. in Champaign, Illinois, and the Secretary of Health and Human Services, as a home health agency in the Medicare program, will be terminated.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has determined that Precious Nurses Health Care Agency, Inc. is not in compliance with the following Medicare Conditions of Participation for home health agencies:

- 42 CFR §484.65 Quality Assessment and Performance Improvement
- 42 CFR 484.102 Establishment of the Emergency Program
- 42 CFR §484.105 Organization and Administration of Services
- 42 CFR §484.110 Clinical Records

The Medicare program will not make payment for home health services furnished to patients whose plan of treatment was established on or after December 31, 2019. For patients whose plan of treatment was established prior to December 31, 2019, payment will be made for up to 30 days of covered services furnished after December 31, 2019.
