



MEDICARE NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Notice is hereby given that on June 11, 2021 the agreement between First Choice Home Health Services, Inc., 6 N. Morgan Boulevard, Suite 101, Valparaiso, Indiana and the Secretary of Health and Human Services, as a home health agency in the Medicare program, will be terminated.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has determined that First Choice Home Health Services is not in compliance with the following Medicare Condition of Participation for home health agencies.

- 42 CFR §484.60 – Care Planning, Coordination of Services, and Quality of Care
- 42 CFR §484.65 – Quality Assessment and Performance Improvement (QAPI)
- 42 CFR §484.70 – Infection Prevention and Control
- 42 CFR §484.80 – Home Health Aide Services
- 42 CFR §484.102 – Emergency Preparedness
- 42 CFR §484.105 – Organization and Administration of Services
- 42 CFR §484.110 – Clinical Records

The Medicare program will not make payment for home health services furnished to patients whose plan of treatment was established on or after June 11, 2021. For patients whose plan of treatment was established prior to June 11, 2021, payment will be made for up to 30 days of covered services furnished after June 11, 2021.

If the provider demonstrates substantial compliance with all CMS requirements, and a revisit survey confirms substantial compliance, prior to June 11, 2021, the provider will remain active in the Medicare Program and CMS will not terminate their provider agreement.

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
