**Title** **Limitation** of CLIA Certificate

On **June 19, 2026**, the laboratory's CLIA certificate, located at Urologic Associates 1221 S Broadway, Lexington, KY 40504, CLIA number: **18D0323225** will be **limited in the subspecialty of Routine Chemistry** due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements.

The laboratory was notified on June 4, 2026.

When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is **limited**, it will not be permitted to perform any testing for the purpose of providing information for the diagnosis, prevention, treatment of any disease or impairment of, or the assessment of the health of human beings, in the testing area where it is limited. The laboratory may continue to perform parallel testing on specimens if needed to implement corrective actions; however, the laboratory may not report any test results during the period of limitation.
