Notice to Public of Removal of Termination Action of Union Home Health Care Services, LLC

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that Union Home Health Care Services, LLC, will not be terminated from the Medicare program as a Home Health Agency. The Medicare provider agreement between the Home Health Agency and the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) will continue based on their correction of deficiencies which were the basis for the termination action.

CMS requires facilities to meet certain health and safety standards to be certified as a Medicare provider. Involuntary termination of a provider agreement is generally a last resort after all other attempts to remedy the deficiencies at a facility have been exhausted. In this instance, the CMS, Northeast Division of Survey, Certification & Enforcement – Region I/Boston, has found that Union Home Health Care Services, LLC is now in compliance with CMS basic health and safety requirements.
