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**Medicare and Medicaid Notice to the Public**

Notice is hereby given that on October 24, 2020 the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Hallmark Living Holland, Holland, MI as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program will be terminated. In addition, as authorized by the Hallmark Living Holland, notice is given that the facility's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will be terminated effective October 24, 2020. This notice supersedes our previous notice dated August 31, 2020.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has determined that Hallmark Living Holland has failed to attain substantial compliance with the following Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements:

- 42 CFR 483.12 – Freedom from Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation
- 42 CFR 483.21 – Comprehensive Resident Centered Care Plans
- 42 CFR 483.25 – Quality of Care
- 42 CFR 483.35 – Nursing Services
- 42 CFR 483.70 – Administration
- 42 CFR 483.80 – Infection Control

The Medicare program will not make payment for skilled nursing facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after August 15, 2020. For residents admitted prior to August 15, 2020, payment may continue to be made for up to 30 days of services on or after October 24, 2020, the date of termination.

In addition, Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after August 15, 2020. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to August 15, 2020, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after October 24, 2020, the date of termination.

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
