

**Michigan MI Health Link (MHL) Capitated Financial Alignment Model Demonstration  
Summary of Changes to the Three-Way Contract**

The three-way contract was re-executed effective January 1, 2022 with the following changes:

- Updated the demonstration end date to December 31, 2023 (5.7.1.1)
- Incorporated into the full version of the contract updates made in the short amendments executed on 1/1/2019 and 9/1/2020
- Reflected changes to Medicare requirements (for example, marketing and enrollee communications requirements in 2.14.7 and 2.14.8)
- Reflected changes to enrollee appeals, including Medicare Part B drug appeal timeframes (2.11.2.7) and withdrawals of appeals (2.11.3.6)
- Added language to reflect the importance of the social determinants of health, health disparities and health equity, including as part of MHL plans' quality improvement efforts (2.13.1.1, 2.13.3.4.1.1, 2.13.3.4.6 and others)
- Added a requirement for MHL plans to develop a performance improvement initiative to reduce burden for providers of long-term services and supports (2.13.5.1.8)
- Adjusted care coordination requirements such as:
  - Implementing care coordinator caseload requirements (2.5.3.4)
  - Implementing a deadline to risk stratify new members (2.6.1.4)
  - Implementing additional standards for automatically stratifying members as high risk (2.6.1.6)
  - Requiring more contact attempts for unable-to-reach members (2.6.3.1.4)
  - Implementing a standardized member assessment (2.6.3.4)
  - Requiring care coordinators have access to and are informed of all Adverse Benefit Determinations, including those made by First Tier, Downstream, and Related entities (2.11.7.1)
- Implemented use of MHL plan experience data in rate setting (2.17.6.5, 4.2.1.2)
- Updated the terms of the medical loss ratio (MLR) to reflect two additional demonstration years (4.3.2)
- Updated provisions throughout the contract to reflect two additional demonstration years, including savings percentages (4.2.3.1) and quality withhold percentages (4.4.7)
