Background

CR 13617 updates the gap-filling DMEPOS fees to include update factors for gap-filling purposes. CMS uses gap-filling in establishing fee schedule amounts for new DMEPOS items or services that don't have a fee schedule pricing history.

Note: When gap-filling for capped rental items, it's necessary to first gap-fill the purchase price and then compute the base period fee schedule at 10% of the base period purchase price.

For used equipment, we establish fee schedule amounts at 75% of the fee schedule amount for new equipment.

Gap-filling isn't used in establishing fee schedule amounts for new lymphedema compression treatment items that don't have a fee schedule pricing history. Information on payment for lymphedema compression treatment items is available in Section 181.1, Medicare Claims
