Action Needed

Make sure your billing staff knows about updates to National Coverage Determinations (NCDs), effective January 1, 2027.

Key Updates

Relevant coding changes in CR 14537 include:

- NCD 90.2—Next Generation Sequencing (NGS)
- NCD 110.18—Aprepitant for Chemotherapy-Induced Emesis
- NCD 150.3—Bone (Mineral) Density Studies
- NCD 220.4—Mammograms
- NCD 250.4—Treatment of Actinic Keratosis
- NCD 270.3—Blood-Derived Products for Chronic Non-Healing Wounds

Note: MACs won't search for claims but will adjust claims you bring to their attention.

Background

CR 14537 updates ICD-10 conversions and other NCD-specific coding updates. These NCD coding changes result from newly available codes, separately released NCD coding revisions, or coding feedback CMS gets.

Translations from ICD-9 to ICD-10 aren't consistent 1-to-1 matches, nor are all ICD-10 codes that appear in a complete General Equivalence Mappings or other mapping guides appropriate when reviewed against individual NCD policies.
