Notice to Public of De-certification of Network for Hope

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has determined that Network for Hope no longer meets the requirements for certification as a qualified organ procurement organization (OPO). Notice is hereby given that on November 3, 2026, CMS will terminate the Medicare agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Network for Hope, 10301 Linn Station Rd, Louisville, Kentucky, 40223 and de-certify Network for Hope as a qualified organ procurement organization.

No Medicare and Medicaid payments will be made with respect to organ procurement costs attributable to Network for Hope on or after November 3, 2026.

The Donation Service Area for Network for Hope (KYDA) will not be opened for competition until the appeals process is completed or Network for Hope abandons its administrative appeal rights. Pursuant to 42 CFR §486.316(c), a de-certified OPO is not eligible to compete for its own open area or any other open area. CMS may extend Network for Hope's agreement temporarily to allow for the transition of the Donation Service Area to another OPO.

While we understand that this involuntary decertification can be challenging for all parties involved, CMS prioritizes safety and quality of services and will work to ensure a smooth transition to another organ procurement organization for this donation service area.
