Title Limitation of CLIA Certificate

Hackensack Meridian Urgent Care Plus, PC, 31D2311748

On April 23, 2026, the laboratory's CLIA certificate, located at 327 Franklin Avenue, Wyckoff, NJ 07481, was **limited for the analyte of Hemoglobin (HGB)** due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements. In addition, the laboratory's approval to receive Medicare payments was suspended for the analyte of HGB.

The laboratory was notified on April 8, 2026.

When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is **limited**, it will not be permitted to perform any testing for the purpose of providing information for the diagnosis, prevention, treatment of any disease or impairment of, or the assessment of the health of human beings, in the testing area where it is limited. The laboratory may continue to perform parallel testing on specimens if needed to implement corrective actions; however, the laboratory may not report any test results during the period of limitation.
