**SUBJECT:** Revised New York AIP D-SNPs: Release of Final Contract Year 2026 Model Material

We had previously sent out an HPMS notice announcing the release of the model material for New York applicable integrated plan (AIP) D-SNPs. However, the HPMS memorandum that was attached was the memorandum for Idaho AIP D-SNPs. We want to clarify that the Summary of Benefits model that was included was the correct model for New York AIP D-SNPs. The appropriate HPMS memorandum for New York AIP D-SNPs is included below and the NY Summary of model is attached again.

Accompanying this memorandum is a model material for Contract Year (CY) 2026 developed jointly by CMS and New York for AIP D-SNPs operating in New York. There were minimal updates to the CY 2026 model. New York AIP D-SNPs may only use the following CY 2026 model for CY 2026 as directed by CMS and the state.

We are issuing the following integrated D-SNP model material on behalf of the states as outlined in their State Medicaid Agency Contracts:

- **Summary of Benefits (SB):** The SB must be available by October 15, 2025, but can be released as early as October 1, 2025, and posted on plan websites by October 15, 2025.

For the remainder of the required materials described at 45 CFR § 422.2267(e), New York AIP D-SNPs should follow the regulatory guidance outlined in this section as well as any guidance provided by the state in the State Medicaid Agency Contract.
