Notice to the Public of Revocation of Philadelphia Womens Center ’s CLIA Certificate, CLIA Number, 39D1042129 and Cancellation to Receive Medicare Payment

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on December 11, 2025, the CLIA certificate of Philadelphia Womens Center, located at 777 Appletree Street, Philadelphia, PA 19106, will be revoked for one (1) year due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements. In addition, the laboratory’s approval to receive Medicare payments will be canceled.

The laboratory was notified on November 26, 2025 for revocation: When a laboratory’s CLIA certificate is revoked, it is required to cease all patient laboratory testing, including waived and provider-performed microscopy testing regardless of whether or not the laboratory charges for the testing. CMS is committed to patient safety and quality of care.
