Title Limitation of CLIA Certificate

Immuno Reference Lab, 40D0658265

On July 31, 2026, the laboratory's CLIA certificate, located at 562 Avenida Munoz Rivera, San Juan, PR 00918 will be limited for the analyte of carbamazepine due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements. In addition, the laboratory's approval to receive Medicare payments will be canceled.

The laboratory was notified on July 16, 2026.

When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is limited, it will not be permitted to perform any testing for the purpose of providing information for the diagnosis, prevention, treatment of any disease or impairment of, or the assessment of the health of human beings, in the testing area where it is limited. The laboratory may continue to perform parallel testing on specimens if needed to implement corrective actions; however, the laboratory may not report any test results during the period of limitation.
