



## Quick Tips: Marketplace Learning Management System Closing for Plan Year 2020 Registration and Training

### What's happening?

Plan year 2020 Marketplace registration and training for agents and brokers will close, or “go dark,” on the Marketplace Learning Management System (MLMS) on July 17, 2020 at 6:00 PM ET, as we prepare to launch Marketplace registration and training for plan year 2021.

### Things to Consider

- You cannot complete Marketplace agent and broker registration and training for plan year 2020 after the MLMS closes on July 17.
- To be sure your profile is updated (including what consumers see on HealthCare.gov’s Find Local Help) before the MLMS closes, do not sign up for a new plan year 2020 training curriculum (via the MLMS or a CMS-approved vendor) after July 12, 2020.
- Certificates showing you have completed plan year 2020 Marketplace agent and broker registration will not be available after July 17, 2020 when the MLMS closes.

### Next Steps

If you completed all plan year 2020 registration and training steps, including signing the necessary Agreement(s), be sure to print your Registration Completion Certificate(s) prior to July 17, 2020.
