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### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

**A. Background:** The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) awarded two contracts several years ago to consolidate all group health plan and non-group health plan MSP post payment recovery activities. Medicare has saved billions of dollars for the Medicare Trust Fund due to the ongoing recovery initiatives. The CROWD COB workload numbers 079001, 079501, and 079801 are currently being used by the BCRC and the CRC to compile both Part A and Part B MSP recovery savings in the "L" MSP Part A savings report in CROWD.

It was determined recently that based on an upcoming Healthcare Integrated General Ledger Accounting System (HIGLAS) update, the BCRC and the CRC will be able to separate the Part A and Part B MSP data beginning October 2020. This Change Request (CR) instructs the BCRC and CRC to separate the Part B MSP savings from the Part A MSP savings and identify the Part B MSP savings in the "K" report in CROWD using three new CROWD COB workload numbers. This CR also alerts the A/B and Durable Medical Equipment (DME) Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) and the shared systems of this change.

**B. Policy:** The BCRC and CRC identifies Part A and Part B MSP Recovery Savings in the CROWD system.
