I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES: This Change Request (CR) describes changes to payment policies initiated under CR 11707 (Updates in the Fiscal Intermediary Shared System (FISS) Inpatient and Outpatient Provider Specific Files (PSF)), for Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNF), Inpatient Psychiatric Facilities (IPF), and Inpatient Rehabilitation Facilities (IRF) to be implemented in the 2021 final rules. Instructions to the Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) will be provided in the corresponding recurring CRs.

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IMPLEMENTATION DATE: October 5, 2020

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: As a result of changes to the wage index policy initiated under CR 11707, we are adding two additional fields, "Supplemental Wage Index" and "Supplemental Wage Index Flag" in the Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF), Inpatient Psychiatric Facility (IPF), and Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Provider Specific File (PSF) to ensure Pricer pays correctly based on values inputted in the PSF. Additional instructions for MACs when to input the new field will be provided in the annual recurring change requests.

B. Policy: Policy: For Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 we made the following change to the wage index for SNF, IPF, and IRF:

- Applied a 5 percent cap for FY 2021 on any decrease in the final wage index from the hospital's final wage index in FY 2020

Input records on claims must include all input items. Output records will contain all input and output items. The Medicare claims processing systems will move the following Pricer output items to the claim record. The return code will be placed in the claim header. The SNF-PAYMENT-RATE amount for each HIPPS code will be placed in the rate field of the appropriate revenue code 0022 line. The Medicare claims processing systems will multiply the rate on each 0022 line by the number of units that correspond to each line. The system will sum all 0022 lines and place this amount in the "Provider Reimbursement" field minus any coinsurance due from the patient. For claims with dates of service on or after July 1, 2002, Pricer will compute payment only where the SNF-RTC is 00.
