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I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: The IDR Shared Systems (IDRSS) currently receives monthly reference file feeds from the three shared systems – the FISS, MCS and VMS. During the implementation of these monthly reference file feeds, specific code sets were requested from each maintainer. Upon recent analysis it has been determined that the IDR is not receiving the Adjustment Reason Code file from FISS.

The addition of this new reference file feed will allow the IDR users to understand the meaning of the FISS Adjustment Reason codes, as they pertain to claims.

B. Policy: The Medicare Program Integrity Group uses the Shared Systems claims data for fraud, waste and abuse detection.
